

HORSE SPONSORSHIP

Our horses are partners with our coaches and volunteers in delivering our RDA programmes to members of our community who are living with challenges.

Working in our environment our horses work closely with our team to be trained to adapt to a diverse range of tasks where they must remain calm and steady to enable our riders to feel safe and achieve their personal goals.

This makes our horses unique.

Horse Sponsorship covers a portion of the costs associated with their care and wellbeing, including:

- · Grazing & pasture maintenance
- Feed (hay and hard feed)
- · Vet, dental and farrier expenses
- Supplements when needed
- Training and handling
- Tack
- Contingency fund

ARENA BOARD OPPORTUNITIES

The MRDA arena is the largest equestrian indoor arena in Marlborough, a size of 60m x 20m. We invite companies to use our arena as an advertising space.
